With reference to your application dated 29/06/2016 and subsequent correspondence with the school inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the grant for Provisional approval of the Competent Authority of the Board for Middle Classes syllabus for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2017 to 31.03.2020.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 830765. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.

The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes.

The school must follow Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI-IX from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards as per Board's Circular No.: Acad-14/2017, dated 21/03/2017.

4. The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular No: CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016, dated 10/11/2016, within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.

5. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State

Govt./UT-Govt. from time to time.

6. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.

7. The grant for approval of the middle classes is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation on the part of the Board to affiliate the Secondary Classes (IX-X).

8. The approval will also be subject to the condition that the school will make a fresh application for Provisional Affiliation of the Secondary Classes (IX-X) to the Board on line through CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in in accordance with the rules and condition for Provisional Affiliation when classes VIII has been started.

9. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under:-

(d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.

(e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

10. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.

11. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State of for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be commensurate the facilities provided by the institution.

28. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

29. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted

by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

30. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.

31. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government

concerned.

32. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.

33. Oool should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would hsure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.

34. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint

qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.

35. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

36. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets

with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.

37. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws. 38. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV.

39. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the

Board every year.

40. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.

41. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another . Sciety/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same remises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.

42. The school should not start Class IX/X without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class IXIX is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws

and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.

43. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-- 8093 sq. mtrs.
